## Budget Your Electricity Bill with the Level Pay Plan

Sign up for SCE's Level Pay Plan, which allows you to spread high summer and/or winter bills over an entire year into equal monthly payments. It's easy. We'll calculate your electricity use over the prior 12 months and come up with a dollar amount. This dollar amount is divided by 11 and becomes the Level Pay Plan amount you pay over the next 11 months (\*amount subject to change). On the 12th month, you'll receive a settlement bill showing either a payment due, or a credit to your account based on how much energy you actually used.

\*Your account is automatically reviewed and your Level Pay Plan monthly amount may be adjusted to reduce your settlement balance in the 12th month.

# Wind Energy Creates Power for SCE Customers

As the nation's leading buyer of renewable energy to serve its customers, SCE uses electricity generated from wind, solar, biomass, geothermal and other renewable energy resources.

Last year, SCE bought 2,495 million kilowatt-hours of power from generators that turn the wind's energy into electricity. A wind project typically consists of many



towers, each holding a single turbine with rotor blades ranging from 80 to 150 feet in length. Two of the state's major wind resource areas, the San Geronio Pass and the Tehachapi Mountains, are located in Southern California, and provide SCE enough wind power every year to supply the electrical needs of about 378,000 homes.
