

Voluntary Contribution for Renewable Energy

California has an ambitious program to generate 20 percent of its energy needs from renewable resources by 2010.

You can help by making a voluntary contribution to California's Renewable Resources Trust Fund. A portion of your contribution will be allocated to purchasing more renewable energy; the rest will be allocated to supporting existing and emerging renewable technologies.

You can make a contribution by writing a separate check to the "Renewable Resources Trust Fund," which is administered by the California Energy Commission. Enclose your contribution check (which is not tax-deductible) with your SCE payment. Please do not send cash.

If someone in your household depends on life-support equipment, you may be eligible for a Medical Baseline Allocation, which allows additional electricity to be billed at the lower "baseline" rate.

SCE also reminds customers who depend on electrically operated medical equipment to have a back-up power system or a plan in case of a power outage.
