



NOTICE OF FILING OF APPLICATION FOR INCREASE IN ELECTRIC REVENUES APPLICATION 07-05-020

On May 17, 2007, SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (SCE) filed an application with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) asking for an increase in electric revenues to fund a feasibility study regarding new electric generation technologies. The application, designated as A.07-05-020, requests that the CPUC authorize an increase of \$52 million in electric revenues. If approved by the CPUC, the electric revenue requirement will increase electric rates by approximately 0.45% in 2008. If the study is approved and if it shows the technology is feasible, SCE will be required to request further Commission approval to fund the construction of a powerplant.

In the application, SCE requests CPUC approval of its proposed study to determine the feasibility of combining several advanced "clean coal" technologies, on a full commercial scale, in an effort to advance emerging approaches to electricity generation with reduced greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. One of the significant aspects of this technology, which SCE calls Clean Hydrogen Power Generation (CHPG), is that it uses a plentiful domestic fuel supply (coal), but produces significantly reduced GHG emissions as compared to conventional pulverized coal generation and traditional natural gas-fired generation. In order to fully conduct this feasibility study, SCE is requesting an increase in its electric revenues of \$52 million, which compared to revenues at present rates, is an increase of approximately 0.45%. The following table shows an estimate of proposed revenue and rate changes by customer group:

Actual rates will be determined by the CPUC through its regulatory process.

ACTION THE CPUC MAY TAKE ON SCE'S APPLICATION

Before acting on SCE's application, the CPUC may hold evidentiary hearings. At the hearing, SCE, the CPUC's independent Division of Ratepayer Advocates ("DRA") and other interested parties may present testimony. Parties may offer proposals that differ from those presented in the application.

After considering all evidence presented, the CPUC will issue a decision on the application. The actual plan adopted by the CPUC may differ from what is requested by SCE in its application.
