

**NOTICE OF FILING OF APPLICATION FOR
INCREASE IN ELECTRIC REVENUES:
APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF 2006-08 ENERGY
EFFICIENCY PROGRAM PLANS AND PUBLIC GOODS
CHARGE AND PROCUREMENT FUNDING REQUESTS
Application 05-06-015**

On June 1, 2005, Southern California Edison Company ("SCE") filed an application with the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC") asking for changes in SCE's electric revenues. The application requests that the CPUC authorize an annual increase of \$50.773 million in electric revenues for a three-year period. If approved by the CPUC, the electric revenue requirement will increase electric rates by less than 1%, most likely effective in 2006.

**APPLICATION FOR 2006 – 2008
ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS AND FUNDING**

SCE has several programs to encourage its customers to install energy efficiency measures. In Application 05-06-015, SCE requested CPUC approval to continue such programs over the 2006 – 2008 period, and to increase annual electric revenues during this period by \$50.773 million to fund these programs.

SCE's illustrative allocation of the \$50.773 million in annual electric revenue requirement increase is shown in the table below:

Customer Group	Revenue Change (\$ millions)	% Change
Residential	17.0	0.49%
Lighting – Small & Medium Power	20.3	0.53%
Large Power	11.7	0.60%
Agricultural & Pumping	1.4	0.53%
Street & Area Lighting	0.4	0.48%
TOTAL	\$50.8	0.53%

ACTION THE CPUC MAY TAKE ON SCE'S APPLICATION

Before acting on SCE's 2006 – 2008 Energy Efficiency application, the CPUC may hold evidentiary hearings. At the hearings, SCE, the CPUC's independent Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) and other interested parties may present testimony. Parties may offer proposals that differ from those presented in this application.

After considering all evidence presented, the CPUC will issue a decision on this application. The actual plan adopted by the CPUC may differ from what is requested by SCE in its application.
