Cost Responsibility Surcharge Undercollection Charge (CRS-UC).

Bundled Service Customers, who were formerly DA Customers, are responsible for payment of the CRS-UC. The proportion paid by each customer shall be a function of the period of time the customer had taken DA service, or had taken Bundled Service and paid the DA-CRS, during the DA-CRS-UC period from September 20, 2001 to December 31, 2005. 1. Cost Responsibility Surcharge Undercollection Charge (CRS-UC):

Bundled Service Customers who were formerly DA Customers are responsible for payment of the CRS-UC. The CRS-UC is the shortfall resulting from the difference between the revenues received from this Schedule and Schedule DA-CRS, and actual costs. The Commission has adopted a cap to limit the DA-CRS. Revenues that are uncollected from DA Customers due to the Commission imposed limit will be collected from the customers described herein regardless of whether these customers are taking DA or Bundled Service in the future.

- a. The CRS-UC charge is the proportion of rate assessed for the under-collection for customers that had been DA for the entire period from September 20, 2001 to December 31, 2005.
- b. The proportion paid by each customer shall be a function of the period of time the customer had taken DA service, or had taken Bundled Service and paid the DA-CRS, during the DA-CRS-UC period from September 20, 2001 to December 31, 2005.

1. Cost Responsibility Surcharge Undercollection Charge (CRS-UC): (Continued) (T)

Bundled Service Customers, who were formerly DA Customers, are responsible for payment of the CRS-UC. (Continued)

- c. All customers who took DA service during the DA-CRS-UC period shall pay the CRS-UC except to the extent that DA Customers did not contribute to the undercollection; such customers are exempt from the CRS-UC. Customers cannot avoid this charge by election of bundled or DA service.
- d. Payment of the CRS-UC shall continue until the CRS-UC is recovered (the "DA-CRS recovery period"). The DA-CRS recovery period shall end for all customers at the same time.

2. Definitions. (T)

- a. Bundled Service Customer: A customer whose electric power, transmission, distribution, billing, metering and related services are provided by SCE.
- b. Continuous DA Customer: Pursuant to Resolution E-3843, continuous DA Customers are those customers who switched to DA service on or before February 1, 2001 and never switched back to Bundled Service, or did not switch back to Bundled Service until after September 20, 2001. By D.04-08-039, refunds are due to continuous DA Customers who paid a DA CRS prior to December 4, 2003. Continuous DA customers shall be exempt from the DA-CRS-UC. (T)
- c. Direct Access Customer: An End-Use Customer located within Southern California Edison's service territory who obtains its electric power and ancillary services from an Electric Service Provider (ESP).
- d. DA-Eligible Bundled Service Customer: A DA-Eligible Bundled Service Customer is a DA-eligible Customer receiving Bundled Service at the present time.
- e. DA-Eligible Customer: A DA-eligible Customer is a customer who received DA service prior to the suspension of DA service on September 20, 2001 or who was placed on an ESP list pursuant to D.02-03-055 because they had a DA contract in effect as of September 20, 2001. A DA-eligible Customer may be either a DA or Bundled Service Customer at the present time and still be considered DA-eligible.
