

Pumping and Agricultural Real-Time Pricing



Minimize your annual energy costs by maximizing real-time savings



Benefit by shifting or reducing energy usage to times when temperatures (and electricity prices) are lower

- **Temperature based price changes**

All bundled service agricultural and water pumping customers may take advantage of savings from Southern California Edison's (SCE) Pumping and Agricultural Real-Time Pricing (PA-RTP) rate schedule. This rate is beneficial to customers with the flexibility to shift or reduce energy usage to times when temperatures (and electricity prices) are lower.

Under Rate Schedule PA-RTP, customers are billed hourly electricity prices that vary based on the time of day, season and temperature. SCE uses temperatures based on data recorded the previous day from Downtown Los Angeles, as recorded by the National Weather Service.

Customers participating in PA-RTP may receive SCE courtesy notification of temperature-based price changes, but there are no specific requirements for customers to reduce energy consumption.

Who Qualifies for PA-RTP?

All bundled service agricultural and water pumping customers are eligible for PA-RTP. These

are customers who use 70% or more of their electricity for general agricultural purposes, or for general water/sewage pumping — and none of any remaining electrical usage is for purposes to which a domestic rate schedule is applicable.

In most cases, if a customer's maximum demand is expected to exceed 500 kW, or has done so for any three months during the previous 12 months, they may not be eligible for this rate. Should this occur, the account would be transferred to Rate Schedule Real-Time Pricing (RTP-2) or the customer could select another applicable rate.

Seasons and Holidays

With PA-RTP, energy prices are higher in summer than in winter. The greatest difference occurs during summer weekdays, when temperatures are highest. SCE's summer season begins on June 1 and continues until October 1 of each year. The winter season begins October 1 and continues until June 1 of the following year. Holidays are recognized as off-peak periods, with

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holidays falling on Sunday recognized as off-peak on the following Monday (there is no change for holidays falling on Saturdays).

Acquiring Temperature Information

Temperature monitoring is the key to achieving the benefits of PA-RTP. Temperatures are based on the prior day's Downtown Los Angeles high temperature, as recorded by the National Weather Service and accessed by the customer for monitoring purposes at www.wrh.noaa.gov/lox/. When weather data is not available from Los Angeles, data collected from the Long Beach Airport is used.

Meter Equipment

Customers interested in PA-RTP are required to have interval meters (IDR, at a minimum). If you don't have an interval meter, SCE will install one free of charge.

Participation in Other Demand Response Programs

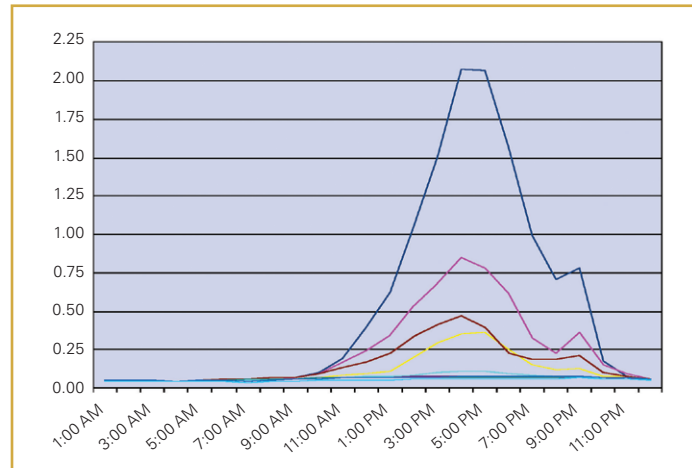

Example of Rate Variations

PA-RTP rate variations are based on time of day, day of week and temperature. The chart below provides examples of possible hourly rate variations for secondary voltage, with the greatest variation occurring on summer weekdays at 4:00 p.m. when temperatures are above 95° (generally, higher temperatures would result in higher price variations):

Secondary Voltage Cost per kWh
