Under 18 CFR 4.3.4 (i)(6)(ii), Southern California Edison (SCE) is required to submit a report summarizing the progress made in the pre-filing consultation process and referencing the Applicant's public file, where additional information on that process can be obtained. SCE maintains a record of its pre-filing consultation process in its relicensing website for the Big Creek Hydroelectric System. To satisfy the regulatory requirement, SCE, after consultation with Commission staff, is providing nine copies of SCE's Big Creek Relicensing website in Adobe Acrobat format on the accompanying CD-ROMs to the Commission.

It is our understanding from Commission staff that this information satisfies the requirement of the referenced regulation. The information is available to the general public at [HTTP://www.scehydro.com](http://www.scehydro.com). A copy of the Initial Information Package for this process is included in the website reproduced on the CD-ROM. The Initial Information Package was initially distributed to the public on May 16-17, 2000 and is available to the general public via the Internet.
